

A Resolution for United States Citizenship and Security

1 Whereas, there are up to twenty-million illegal immigrants currently in the United States,
2 and;

3 Whereas, mass deportation of said immigrants is impractical, and;

4 Whereas, amnesty has often been regarded as a practical and essential solution for the
5 security of America, and;

6 Whereas, an increase in border security is necessary for the safety of all citizens, and;

7 Whereas, lax enforcement of immigration policies has created a generation of
8 undocumented individuals;

9 BE IT RESOLVED by the Congress here assembled that all individuals living in the
10 United States of America illegally, shall be given the opportunity to apply for full
11 citizenship.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in order to stop a recurrence as this, and to provide
13 for the safety and security of all Americans, Congress allocates \$400 million to the
14 Immigration and Customs Enforcement of the United States Department of Homeland
15 Security for improvement of border security through an increase in personnel, heightened
16 awareness amongst state and local governments, and overall improvement to national
17 security.
